REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

All clubs, members of the National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. Each club has the right to enter competitors in any category and class.

To participate, please complete the entry form available at <http://helsinkitrophy.fi/> no later than **1.9.2017**. Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted.

The clubs are asked to enter the skaters in the order of preference in which they wish the skaters to be accepted to the competition. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of skaters in any category or class. The organizing club has the right to enter more participants than other clubs.

Confirmation of entries and preliminary schedule will be announced **5.9.2017** on competition web page. The final schedule with starting orders will be published on the competition website on **22.9.2017**.

Entry fees will be invoiced soon after confirmation and the invoice must be paid latest on due date **15.9.2017**.

In case a skater/pair has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Participating clubs are asked to immediately inform of any changes in their entries by emailing helsinki trophy@hl.fi.

CANCELLATIONS

After 15.9.2017, only cancellations supported with a medical certificate will be refunded.

DRAW

The draw will be conducted on **22.9.2017** by a random number generator in Finnish Star Evaluation categories and by ISU Calc program in ISU categories. The result of the draw will be





published on the competition website immediately afterwards.

MUSIC

All Competitors shall provide competition music on CD (no CD-RW-s or DVD-s). CD must state the full name of the competitor, category, name of club and country. Please note that the own music for ice dance pattern dances should be also in separate CD. The participants are obliged to present their music records at the accreditation desk. All competitors must have an extra copy of their music available at the rink during their event.

ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation desk will be at the Pirkkola Ice Hall.

PRACTICE ICE

There will be no practice ice available.

JUDGES

The organizer will invite the judges and the other officials and pay their expenses. The names of the judges and technical panel will be published on the competition website.

PROTOCOL / LIST OF RESULTS

Protocol/ list of results in each category will be published on the website of the competition.

PROTESTS

Protest must be submitted in writing to the Referee of the category at the latest 30 minutes after the category. The protest fee is 15 €. The Referee's decision is final.

AWARDS

The three best placed skaters in each category will be announced and awarded. All participants will receive a diploma.

EXPENSES

The organizer will not cover any expenses of the skaters.

LIABILITY





According to the ISU Regulations, Rule 119, the organizer accepts no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury, property loss or damage suffered by the competitors or officials during the competition.

Participants are expected to have their own insurance. Such insurance must assure full medical coverage and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

FIRST AID

Qualified first-aid personnel will be present at the competition.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

Skaters, coaches and other team members are responsible for booking their accommodation individually if required. The organizer will not arrange transportation for participants.
