# **Icebeat Winter Trophy 2023**

Figure Skating Competition in Single Skating

February 10-12, 2023 Kaunas, Lithuania

#### 1. GENERAL

The Icebeat Winter Trophy 2023 Competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Icebeat Winter Trophy 2023 is open to all competitors.

#### 2. Venue

All competition events will take place at:

Kaunas Ice Palace Kovo 11-osios st. 26, Kaunas, Lithuania The Rink is indoor and heated, with two ice rinks

### 5. Entries

#### 5.1. Entry form

Entries have to be made before the deadline by filling the Online Registration Form, which is available on competition website: <u>icebeat.lt/registration</u>.

The Planned Program Content is also filled during registration. It is mandatory that the Planned Program Content must be filled in precisely by each Skater in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Upon completing the Registration form please upload your competition music in MP3 or WAV format (see Paragraph 8. Music).

#### 5.2. Deadline of entries

All entries are expected not later than January 20, 2023.

The Invoice will be sent after the registration using the details filled in the registration form.

The entry fee must be paid by bank transfer no later than **January 27, 2023**.

Entries will be confirmed and accepted only after receiving the Entry Fee in time.

#### 5.4. Cancelation

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

If a participant withdraws from the competition he or she can be replaced with the other Competitor from the Team.

## 6. Expenses

The Organizer will provide accommodation and cover travel expenses for invited Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

The expenses for accommodation, meal, travel and transfer of the Team Officials will not be covered by the Organizer and are on the account of the Teams.

# 7. Insurance / Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the Organizer and the ISU accept no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors and Officials. Each ISU Member is expected to provide its own insurance protection for the Officials and Competitors.

### 8. Music

Music will be reproduced from the computer. In order tu ensure the smooth execution of the competition, all Competitors are requested to send their competition music in MP3 or WAV format during the registration by filling the Online Entry Form (see Paragraph 5).

The music has to be of excellent quality and named with Competitor's first name, family name, category and segment (eg. carolina\_kostner\_senior\_sp).

In addition Competitors must have a back-up drive (USB stick) for each program d the format of a MP3 or WAV file.

#### 9. Draw

There will be an electronic Draw, which will be held on Febraury 9, 2023. The Starting Orders after the Draw will be available at the competition website <u>icebeat.lt</u> and will be sent to the participants by e-mail.

Starting orders for the Free Skating for Advanced Novice, Juniors and Seniors will be the reverse order of the results of the Short Program in accordance with Rule 513, paragraph 2.

#### 10. Awards

All the Competitors in each category will be honored. The first three best placed Competitors in each category will be awarded with medals and trophies during award ceremony. Diplomas and souvenirs will be provided for all participants.

# 11. Opening Show

All the Competitors are invited to participate in the Opening Show on ice. The time of the show and more details will be announced on competition website.

## 12. Seminar / Workshops

There will be a seminar and workshop like activities planned for all age groups and levels to offer participants the best experience during the competition. All the information about the moderator and the activities itself will be released soon on competition website.

Also the organizer will offer the qualified assistance of a seminar moderator for skaters coming without coaches. Including but not limited to the assistance during practices, warm-ups and performances. The detailed information will be announced on competition website.

## 13. Accommodation

The Magnus Hotel will be the official Hotel for Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators. Competitors are also invited to stay at Magnus Hotel.
